

The Kingdom in the Acts of the Apostles & Paul's epistles

a1	Acts 1:3 – Christ's subject during 40 days	
a2	Acts 1:6 – restoring to Israel?	
a3	Acts 8:12 – Philip in Samaria	Gospel of kingdom, name of Jesus Christ
a4	Acts 14:22 – Paul in Galatia	Enter kingdom of God through many tribulations
a5	Acts 19:8 – synagogue in Ephesus	Reasoning with them on kingdom of God, resisted what? The Way (“word of the Lord”, v 10)
a6	Acts 20:25 – Paul to Ephesian elders (Miletus)	“among whom I preached the kingdom of God”
a7	Acts 28:23 -- Jewish leaders in Rome	“Thorough witness concerning kingdom of God”, all day, from Law & prophets, persuading them about Jesus
a8	Acts 28:31 – 2 years in lockdown	“preaching the kingdom of God & teaching about the Lord Jesus Christ”
p1	Romans 14:17 – on private conscience	“kingdom of God does not mean eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit”
p2	I Corinthians 4:20 – defending his apostleship	“For the kingdom of God does not consist in talk but in power.”
p3,4	1 Corinthians 6:9, 10 – moral boundaries of discipleship	Unrighteous will not inherit kingdom of God (said twice – again linked to work of Spirit, v 11)
p5	1 Corinthians 15:24 -- “the end”	“when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule & every authority & power”
p6	1 Corinthians 15:50 – nature of the resurrection	“flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God”
p7	Galatians 5:21 – works of the flesh	“those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God” (the fruit of the Spirit follows immediately)
p8	Ephesians 5:5 – moral impurity	“no inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God”
p9	Colossians 1:13 – our inheritance	“delivered us from the domain of darkness & transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in Whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins”
p10	Colossians 4:11 – Paul's fellow workers	Aristarchus, Mark, Jesus called Justus “the only men of the circumcision among my fellow workers for the kingdom of God”
p11	1 Thessalonians 2:12 – the Christian walk	“walk in a manner worthy of God, who calls you into his own kingdom and glory”
p12	2 Thessalonians 1:5 – role of suffering	“that you may be considered worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are also suffering”
p13	2 Timothy 4:1 – judgment day	“Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearance and his kingdom”
p14	2 Timothy 4:18 – Paul's last word, & hope	“The Lord will ... bring me safely into his heavenly kingdom”
